This document tells you about **your rights.**



Australian laws respect the rights of people with disability. The laws say you:

- Should be **included in community life.**
- Have the **same rights** as all
- other Australians.

What are your human rights?



You should be:

- **Safe** in your home and anywhere else.
- Treated with **respect.**
- Part of your cultural **community.**



You should be able to:

- **Participate** in your **religion**.
- Express your **sexuality**.
- Communicate in your family's **language**.

National 360 will:

- **Involve your family, advocate, and other carers** (if you want us to).

- Ask you to tell us **what supports you want.**
- Keep your **personal information private.**



You can safely:

- Make complaints and provide feedback to us.
- Tell us you want to use another provider.
